Senses Foundation have invited Paul Hart and Megan Mann, two internationally renowned trainers in the field of deafblindness, to deliver two modules from the UK accredited Diploma in Deafblind Studies course. The course examines how a person who is deafblind can be disabled by their environment and by people's assumptions about them and equips workers to identify these issues. The course is underpinned by very sound Values and Principles.

TWO MODULES ARE OFFERED

24th & 25th May 2010 Module 1 Dual Sensory Impairment

This module will provide an overview of the issues commonly associated with deafblindness, an understanding of the causes and physiology and the historic perspective.

26th & 27th May 2010 Module 2 Communication

This module will provide an overview of the development and use of communication and language and how deafblindness impacts on both.

COST

The cost for each individual module is \$450 AUD (Early Bird \$395 AUD)
The cost for registration to both modules is \$799 AUD (Early Bird \$699 AUD)
